Grape variety / Lagrein

Growing Area / Gries- Bolzano, 250 m a.s.l.

Soil / Alluvial soils deposited by the River Talvera, with alternating sandy and gravelly layers to a depth of up to 10 meters. Porphyry is predominant.

Training system / Guyot; 6.000-7.000 vines/hectare and traditional Pergola

Yield / 60 hl/hectare

Harvest date / beginning of October

Age of vines / up to 50 years

Vinification / manual harvest and selection of the grapes, fermentation in open-top oak vats for about 3 weeks; malolactic fermentation and aging in barriques and oak vats for 12-14 months

Acidity / 5,7 g/l

Residual Sugar / 0,5 g/l
